RIGHTS RESPECTING SCHOOLS BRONZE AWARD We are a Rights Respecting School and have been since May 2010.

The Rights Respecting Schools Award is a UNICEF programme that aims to put children's rights at the heart of school's work. Currently we are working towards achieving the bronze award. The award helps us as a staff encourage our children to grow into confident, caring and responsible young people both in school and within the wider community.

Children's rights are:

UNIVERSAL - Rights are for all children all over the world

INHERENT - All children are born with these rights

INALIENABLE - Rights cannot be taken away

UNCONDITIONAL - Rights do not have to be earned

INDIVISIBLE - All rights are equally important

We will begin to talk with the children about Rights, setting out expectations about how children's rights can be met by adults at Kylemore Nursery School.

I'll be back in the morning with my bill, bill, bill!




Row, Row, Row Your Boat
